5. OLD BUSINESS
 - a. All-District results.
 - i. Boosters donated candy & drinks for tryouts
 - ii. 28 students made it and congrats given to ALL that tried out

 1. Signup genius worked great for getting and tracking volunteers. Will keep using for volunteer options.
 - ii. Over 400 kids attended the dance: concession and photo booth pulled in extra above tix sales.
 - iii. Gross: \$7,574.35; expense: \$1,450.31 Net profit: \$6,124.04
 - c. Booster Club website is up and running. People can join the boosters for \$20/family cost. Must be member to extra benefits from booster club. 6-8th grade families can join for free and volunteer anytime.
 - i. What perks for 6-8 grade parents for joining or volunteering?

 - ii. T-shirts and hoodies are for sale on the website. This is a now work for us fundraising option that can stay open year-round.
6. NEW BUSINESS
 - a. Volunteer credit for NY coming out in the following week. Credit is an hourly rate earned for volunteer hours put in at booster club events. Parents and students can both work. Must be a booster member to earn credit. This year is only for NY trip, in future may be for more. Rate paid out is hour rate based on predefined % of net profit of each event. Rate was defined and voted on by board prior to the start of the school year.
 - i. Can rate be changed was discussed during this meeting. Suggested rate not be changed without booster club discussion and vote. Meeting was not large enough attendance to act on anything at time so was decided to remain the same.
 - ii. Amounts for spaghetti dinner and homecoming dance volunteers will be coming out and added to student accounts.
 - iii. There is a % of all profits that is designated to go to all choir members going on the NY trip. This % was predefined and voted on by board prior to the school year. This amount is to be evenly spilt and divided to

ALL students attending the trip despite if they are booster members or have volunteered.

- iv. Lastly, there is a % of profits for general fund. This fund is to help pay for events and expenses of the club and choir that are coming up. Ie: Boar's head Feast, choir funding exceptions, emergency expenses, fundraising expenses, etc.
 - I. Group discussion: what events or groups could best benefit from this? What would we like to see out of this? Can help go beyond just high school choirs? Could some support go into younger choirs to gain more attendance & interest in booster club?
 - a. Asked if middle school dance profit could go to middle school choirs if run by middle school parents and volunteers. Possibly, but high schoolers and booster members volunteering would still get their credit for the trip if they are still in need.
 - b. Mummy & Son Dance is Oct. 28th @ CUE. It's being lead by Ashley Ward and Susan Scott. Tickets will go on sale at elementary schools next week.
 - i. Flyer was shown for approval and open for suggestions
 - ii. Elementary Principal is going to DJ
 - iii. Costume contest! Discussion on best way to do this? What prizes would be good? Suggested tickets to concession stand.
 - iv. Volunteers will be on signup genius: credit can be earned for NY trip
 - I. Lots of open times and options to earn credit Fri and Sat
 - v. Concession stand will be there. Drinks and candy will be leftovers from homecoming. Plenty to cover it.
 - vi. Photo Booth again
 - c. Boar's Head Feast is Dec 8th, 9th, & 10th
 - i. Ideas for donations of meat, sides, drinks discussed.
 - ii. Volunteers WILL BE NEEDED for this one. Volunteers will get a free ticket to attend the feast. Booster members will warn credit again on this one.
