CLUB MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER 5:35

- A. Approval/Changes to the agenda: *Lisa/Melinda*
- B. Approval of last month's minutes: *James/Melinda*
- C. Treasurer's Report: *Susan: Accidental charge to the account when treasure used card by mistake. All charges have been corrected and reimbursed to account. Paper trail to show all activity is available. Balance at this time is \$8,463.21. This amount is to cover expenses for the rest of this year as well as required end year balance and boar's head savings.*

2. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Flowers for Cards on Broadway Feb 4
 - i. *Flower sales test run was a success. All flowers were sold and people showed positive feelings on them. Cost of test run was \$60 with a profit of \$211 (\$182 cash with \$29 venmo)*
 - ii. *Flowers were approved and we will sell again. Next run will be for musical where we will try it with carnations as they are the flowers in the play.*

3. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Lacy - Hadestown Carnation sales
 - i. **Suggested we plan for 300 flowers instead of the original 150 proposed.** ~~150~~ Red = 76.62 (that's 50 per night); Order needs to be made at least 2 weeks prior to show
 - ii. **Flower sales for musical have already been put before school board and approved.**
 - iii. **Voted to keep \$5 price & adjust the flower # per bundle. Was voted for due to keeping easy pricing for those wanting to purchase.**
 - iv. Carnations are going to need more storage than Lacy's fridge. James volunteered some space.
 - v. Ribbon is good; need more gift tags and wrapping
 - vi. Tags @ 120pcs (comes with precut twine we could use this time?) \$6.59

- vii. Tissue Paper @ 80 sheets \$5.49 (need x2 MAYBE, almost everyone bought multiple flowers in one wrap last time, so we could get away with just doing 1 plus leftovers and if we run out there's Target/Walmart/etc.)
- viii. Total to get flowers started = \$88.70ish

B. Lacy - Printing playbills for Hadestown

- i. Bigfoot Print shop in town is willing to do 150 12-page playbills in full color for \$175
- ii. Ad space sold by full page, ½ page, ¼ page
- iii. Ask Samantha to send home flier for "parent shout out" ads with cast/crew
- iv. Everything due to the printer by 4/9-ish
- v. @12 pages we have about \$300 worth of ad space available. @16 pages we have \$700 worth of ad space available

C. Ms. Taylor - Hadestown Billboard Cost

- i. Now over \$700 vs we budgeted amount. Ms. Taylor has asked if we could pay for contest music from Finland instead of the billboard since the price went up so much. Ben suggested we pay for the music as well as the Hadestown program printing and promotional posters. The cost of the 3 will be about the same as the original projected billboard cost.

D. Ms. Taylor - Choir Contest Music

- i. 30 copies needed
- ii. \$230 USD (ordered from Finland)
 - 1. Boosters unanimously voted yes. Music has been purchased and choir loves it.*
